Aloe Barbadosis Leaf Juice: Aloe Vera, known as a first-aid plant, is expressed from the leaf of the aloe. From South Africa, this lily-like plant is employed for its supposed softening benefits in skin creams.

Sweet Almond Seed Extract: A naturally occurring protein peptide that enhances to skin's ability to product collagen. Acts as a skin conditioner widely used in makeup, hair products, and bath products.

Panthenol: Dexpanthenol. Vitamin B Complex Factor. Widely used in hair products and emollients, and as a supplement in foods. Employed medically to aid digestion. It is good for human tissues.

Phospholipids: A phosphatides complex fat substance found in all living cells. Widely used in hand creams and lotions to bind water and hold it in place.

Bergamot Fruit Oil: Direct result of cold expression from peel of fresh, nearly ripe fruit. Contains approximately 300 compounds in the oil including terpenes. Used as an aromatic.

Grapefruit (Citrus Grandis) Oil: Volatile oil obtained from the pulp of grapes. Contains monoterpenes, hydrocarbons, limonene and sesquiterpenes. Reported to be a lymphatic stimulant, nourishes the tissue cells, stimulates bile secretion and controls liquid processes in the body. Has an astringent effect on the skin. Also used in fragrances.

Lemon (Citrus Medica Limonum) Oil: Obtained from the citrus lemon tree. Volatile oil expressed from the fresh peel. Contains essential oils, pectin, organic and amino acids. Celebrated for its toning, cleansing, purifying and brightening properties. Used in oily skin preparations.

Orange Oil: Sweet Orange Oil with a characteristic orange taste and odor expressed from the fresh peel of the ripe fruit of the sweet orange plant species. Once used as an expectorant, it is now employed in perfumery, soaps, and flavorings. Helps to tone and brighten a dull ashen complexion.

Grapefruit (Citrus Grandis) Oil: Volatile oil obtained from the pulp of grapes. Contains monoterpenes, hydrocarbons, limonene and sesquiterpenes.
